

Troop 431 Winter Camping Pack List

Remember when possible to pack clothing in a self sealing (Ziploc-esq) plastic bag. When hiking or trekking to campsite, remember you have to carry your gear, so pack accordingly. Ask your patrol leader if you have any questions.

Required Items

- Scout Shirt
- Scout Handbook
- Snow Boots
- Cotton Socks (1 pair per day)
- Wool Socks
- Underwear
- Thermal Underwear (long johns)
- Pants (Wool or Corduroy preferred)
- Sweat Pants/Sleeping Clothing
- Undershirt
- Flannel Shirt
- Thick sweater (wool preferred)
- Parka/Insulated Jacket
- Stocking cap, or hat with ear protectors
- Mittens (if possible extra pair mitten liners)
- Flashlight
- Plate, cup, utensils
- Sleeping Bag (Mummy if sleeping outdoors)
- Extra sleeping bag (if sleeping outdoors or extra heavy blankets)
- Whistle
- Toothbrush/paste
- Toilet Paper
- Pillow
- Canteen

- Slippers/Shoes (if staying in cabin)
- Personal First Aid Kit (Recommended)
- Ground Mat (Not Air Mattress)
- Sunglasses
